3. Start-It-Right Programme 2023

The school will be conducting a Back-to-School Programme for P2 - P6 Xinminites, which will take place from Wednesday, 4 January to Friday, 6 January during curriculum hours (7.30 a.m. -1.30 p.m.) for all Xinminites. 6. P5 Camp 2023

Primary 5 Xinminites will be going for 3 days of non-residential outdoor camp in in Term 1 Week 10, 6th March to 8th March. This is the first time that we are organising an outdoor camp for our students since the pandemic and we are looking forward to having an enriching experience for the entire P5 level. 7. Driving within the School compound

For parents/guardians who drive their child/ward to school, please note that the main gate of the school will be closed at 7.30am. All access will be via the canteen gate and bus stop gate. If you are dropping your child/ward, you will have to drop him/her at the canteen gate area.

If you are dropping/fetching your child/ward to/from school, please display a XMPS "Drive Through" decal prominently on your window screen to enter the school. If you need a XMPS "Drive Through" decal, please submit your application via FormSG https://form.gov.sg/628c8271035d630012ab9b20.. As the carpark within the school are designated for season parking, you are not allowed to park within the school compound.

Please drive slowly and keep to a speed limit of 15 km/h when you enter the school compound and observe the following:

- a. Train your child/ward to be ready to alight when your car approaches the designated drop-off at the foyer.
- b. Do not get off your vehicle to help your child/ward but train your child/ward to alight swiftly on the side nearest to the kerb.
- c. Do comply with instructions from security guards and traffic wardens on duty.

Temperature taking exercise will be conducted on 11 January 2023 during the first period. All Xinminites are to bring along a working thermometer to facilitate the conduct of this exercise.
